

Admissions decisions are made on a rolling basis as applications are completed and all supporting documents are received. Applications are available beginning **July 1** for the following academic year and you must apply by **November 1** to be considered for merit scholarships.

• Freshmen Automatic Admission Requirements

- High School GPA of 3.5 or higher (4.0 scale)
- SAT score of 1680 (CR+M+WR) or higher or ACT score of 25 or higher.

Undergraduate Application Requirements

- · Application for admission
- Non-refundable \$30 application fee
- Official high school transcripts—sent directly from your high school in a sealed envelope (freshmen)
- Official secondary transcripts/academic records-sent directly from your community college (transfer)
- Official SAT or ACT scores sent directly from collegeboard.org or actstudent.org

Transfer students send portfolio. Also, check <u>prerequisite equivalencies</u> by clicking the link in the second paragraph under "Transfer Students."
