The Masters of Arts in Health Care Design is a post-professional degree (36 credits) to enhance professional credentials with specialized healthcare design expertise. Although grounded in design, this interdisciplinary degree provides opportunities to interact with a variety of stakeholders including other academic disciplines (nursing, medicine, public health, occupational therapy, computer science and bio-medical engineering), health care design professionals and healthcare facilities. By using an evidence-based model, the program strives to address unique regional issues of Miami's international urban community including patient centered design, care models, universal design, aging in place, sustainable communities, wellness and active living.
