Rules for internships Following the Recommendations of the Faculty in the FIU Department of Journalism + Media

- 1. Internship courses are offered only as electives and do not replace courses required for graduation.
- 2. All internship courses are coordinated by a full-time faculty member in the Department.
- 3. The firms providing the internships work with the coordinating faculty member to determine which tasks the interns are working on.
- 4. All students participating in an internship are required to register into the internship course, even when taking a zero-credit internship.
- 5. Internships must be a minimum of 15-20 hours.

- 6. Intern supervisor is required to provide an end-of-semester student intern evaluation and explanation of the projects they worked on; student interns are required to provide an end-of-semester internship evaluation of their experience.
- 7. Students taking the internship course are required to keep a weekly journal of their internship experiences that is accessible to the coordinator.
