- Minutes from last meeting 5 November 2020 approved
- Dean's Report, Dean Brian Schriner
 - o FIU is returning to 3 modalities: face to face, hybrid, online.
 - Summer A continues the social distancing and masks Number of students in sections in half, doubled professors.
 - Summer B is back to face-to-face normal.
 - No requirement to be vaccinated
 - Social distancing standards have been financially tough for FIU. Last year colleges held back 2.5% of budget. That money was returned. This year colleges are again asked to hold back 2.5%,
 - o CARTA will have \$1.5M less next year
 - o CARTA is entitled to apply for bailout funds. Hopefully we will get something back. Yet a balanced budget is due April 15.
 - Graduation 2021 will have some face to face ceremonies. April 24 & 25 and online. April 14 Compass to talk about state of college – topic: student success.
 - Question: Is there student resistance to vaccine? No information on that. University has had vaccine available. Weekly update to students encourages them to be vaccinated
 - Could univ. provide vaccines for students. MEV says that minorities resist because of malpractice in past.
 - Student groups might promote vaccine
 - We don't know how long the vaccine will last
- Faculty Senate Report, Neil Reisner
 - o Faculty Senate has been focused on Curriculum.
 - o GRE requirement for graduate admissions is on hold
 - o Bright Futures was in danger of being limited to STEM. Huge pushback against the law.
 - o Law will require disclosure of gifts from outside the country
 - Now it will be legal for students to record classes without our permission. Exemption to sunshine law
 - o Guns on campus bill will likely die in committee
 - o Panther bookpack students will get texts for \$20/credit.
 - Second exit at BBC is still under discussion
 - Supervisors cannot come into class unannounced
 - o Global Studies course: Piracy in Spanish Atlantic
 - o May 11 end of term,
 - Assignments July 1
